
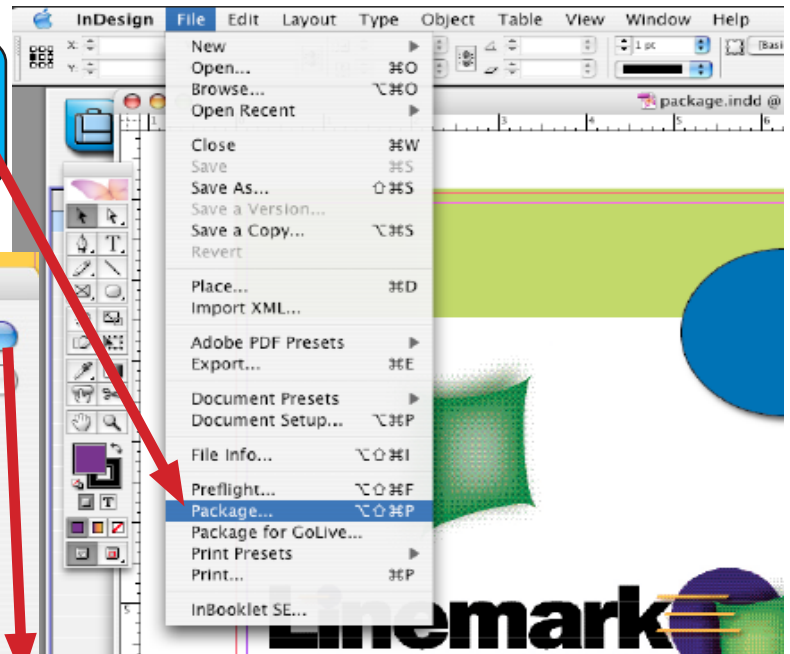


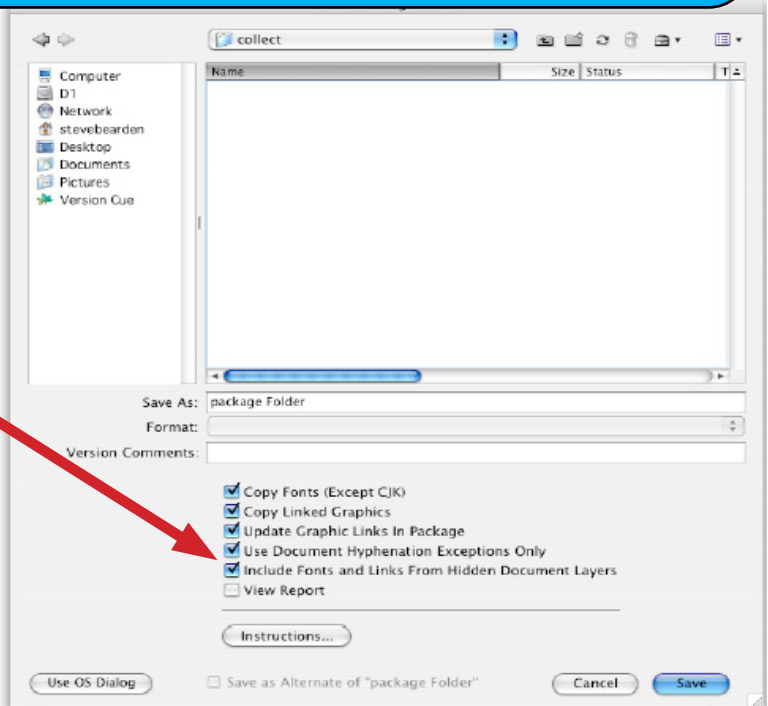
InDesign: Packaging your Project for Printing

1. Choose File > Package
